COMMON PROVISIONS FOR ALL LIFTING EQUIPMENT

ORDER LEAD TIME

In accordance with the collective agreement, equipment orders must be placed as follows :

- ☐ No later than 17:00 on the day before the operation
- ☐ By 17:00 on Friday for the following weekend and Monday. In the event of force majeure (breakdown, failure, weather conditions), this requirement may be revised.

Any order modification must be submitted to the order office by 11:30 a.m. on the same day for afternoon operations.

Failure to comply with these deadlines will result in a 50% surcharge on the service charge.

IMPROPERLY SIZED ORDER

In the event of an improperly sized equipment order requiring a reorganization of teams and/or a call-out of standby personnel, a surcharge will be applied :

- ☐ 25% of the service amount from Monday to Saturday
- ☐ 50% of the service amount on Sundays

WAITING TIMES

In the event of non-use of the ordered equipment due to weather conditions (making it impossible to operate the equipment), vessel delay, or operations completed before the end of the working period, the reduction specified in the tariff for each type of equipment shall apply.

This reduction is applied by the port operator on a pro rata basis of the waiting time, as evidenced by the vessel's time sheet countersigned by the stevedore and the vessel's master.

This provision does not apply to single-hour orders or completion hours.

BREAKDOWNS OF LIFTING EQUIPMENT

In the event of a continuous breakdown lasting more than one hour, the equipment will not be charged for the duration of the breakdown.

3 - DISCOUNTS IN FAVOR OF NEW SHIPPING LINES

Newly established passenger lines shall benefit from the following reductions on the above passenger fee applicable to the passenger terminal :

- ☐ 50% reduction per additional passenger during the first year beyond 25,000 passengers.
- ☐ 50% reduction per additional passenger during the second year beyond 35,000 passengers.
- ☐ 50% reduction per additional passenger during the third year beyond 45,000 passengers.

Reductions are applied, as from January 1st, per operator on the cumulative traffic of the new lines operated from the Port of Sète. When these lines are served by vessels operating on existing lines, any new line operated by these then benefit from the reduction rate applied to the previously opened lines pursuant to hereinafter Article 4.

The reductions are subject to the shipping company's signature of an operating regulation and a security agreement.

4 - REDUCTIONS FOR EXISTING LINES

Existing passenger lines shall benefit from the following reductions on the passenger fee :

- ☐ 40% discount per additional passenger beyond 100,000 passengers
- ☐ 60% discount per additional passenger beyond 120,000 passengers
- ☐ 80% discount per additional passenger beyond 150,000 passengers

As from January 1st, reductions shall be applied per operator on the cumulative traffic of the lines it operates from the Port of Sète. This reduction shall not be combined with the reductions granted to new lines.

The reductions are subject to the shipping company's signature of an operating regulation and a security agreement.

F - ISPS - SECURITY FEE WITH RESTRICTED ACCESS AREA (RAZ)

The security fee applies to ships requiring the systematic establishment of a Restricted Access Area (RAA) in accordance with the ISPS Code. It is applied to the duration of the ship's presence at berth during which the restricted access area is activated.

In the event that additional resources are required to ensure the Restricted Access Area (ZAR), the EPR shall make the necessary arrangements and invoice the companies in accordance with the operating regulations, based on the market cost of security services plus penalties and care.

One-off requests from companies for surveillance/security services are handled under the same conditions.

Implementation of a temporary Restricted Access Area may incur fees at the actual cost plus any additional work required.
